

Cookie Policy for Dr Jenna Wa Skin Surgery

At Dr Jenna Wa Skin Surgery ("we," "us," or "our"), we use cookies and similar tracking technologies on our website to enhance your browsing experience, improve our services, and understand how our site is used. This Cookie Policy outlines what cookies are, how we use them, and your options regarding cookie management.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, smartphone, tablet) by websites that you visit. They help the website remember your actions and preferences (such as login details, language, and other settings) over a period of time so you don't have to re-enter them whenever you return to the site or browse from one page to another.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

2.1. Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function properly. Without these cookies, certain features of the website may not work, such as accessing secure areas, submitting forms, or remembering your privacy preferences.

- Examples: Session management, security, form submissions.

2.2. Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting information about the pages visited, the time spent on the site, and any issues encountered. This data allows us to improve the website's functionality and user experience.

- Examples: Google Analytics, traffic monitoring.

2.3. Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies enable the website to remember choices you have made in the past, such as your language preferences or the region you are in, and provide enhanced, personalised features. - Examples: Remembering login details, language preferences.

2.4. Advertising and Targeting Cookies

These cookies are used to deliver ads that are relevant to you based on your interests. They track your browsing habits and help us understand which services or products may be of interest to you. These cookies may also be set by third-party services such as social media platforms or advertising networks.

- Examples: Personalised ads, third-party advertising platforms.

3. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

- Improve website performance and functionality.
- Remember your preferences and settings.
- Analyse website traffic and user behaviour.
- Offer personalised content and recommendations.
- Deliver relevant ads based on your browsing activity.

We do not use cookies to store sensitive personal data, such as medical information or payment details.

4. Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third-party service providers to place cookies on your device through our website to assist with functionality, performance, advertising, or analytics. For example, we may use Google Analytics to analyse website traffic and user behaviour. These third parties may have access to certain information about your browsing activity but are required to protect your data in accordance with their own privacy policies.

5. Your Cookie Choices

You have the right to control and manage cookies. You can adjust your browser settings to refuse or delete cookies. However, please note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality of our website and limit certain features, such as remembering your preferences or accessing secure areas.
